HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION AND RAPID RE-HOUSING PROGRAM (HPRP)
Request For Proposals

Through Washington State's Department of Commerce, Grant County, Washington is anticipating an award from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development of Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) funds under Title XII of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 in the amount of \$382,288.00. These federal funds are to be used to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless or help those who are experiencing homelessness to quickly be re-housed and stabilized. The County will enter into a sub-recipient agreement with a non-profit agency to be selected as part of this RFP process in December 2009. HPRP funding is focused on providing temporary financial assistance and stabilization services to individuals and families who are homeless or would be homeless but for this assistance. The program is intended to target 2 populations: (1) individuals and families who are currently in housing but are at risk of becoming homeless and need temporary rent or utility assistance to prevent them from becoming homeless; and (2) individuals and families who are experiencing homelessness (residing in emergency or transitional shelters or on the street) and need temporary assistance in order to obtain and maintain housing.

Requests for Proposals may be picked up at the office of the Grant County Board of County Commissioners located at 35 C Street NW in Ephrata, Washington, beginning Thursday, November 12th or *via* the Grant County Website at www.grantcountyweb.us.

The deadline for proposals is 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 3, 2009. An original proposal and three photocopies must be submitted as shown below in a sealed envelope clearly marked with project title: HPRP Program. Late proposals and/or proposals submitted *via* e-mail or facsimile will not be accepted.
